

Summer term overview Class 3

Date: Summer 2017

English

We will be using our class novel Charlotte's Web as a stimulus for our writing. We have already looked at writing letters as characters from Charlotte's Web.

We are going to be writing descriptive poetry around friendship.

We are going to be writing recounts from the perspective of key characters from the novel.

We are then going to focus on writing prequels for the main characters from Charlotte's Web.

Maths

We have focused on place value, as this is fundamental skill in maths. We will then progress onto the 4 operations, multiplication, division, addition and subtraction.

Fractions- We will be looking at counting in tenths, adding and subtracting fractions and comparing different fractions.

Then we will finish the term on measurement topics, money and time.

Topic: Food for thought.

We are going to be looking at the choices of food we have and discussing what foods are classed as healthy and unhealthy food choices.

We will be investigating the different nutritional value of cereals and what sugar content is in different cereals.

We will be tracking the food from our school kitchen to discover how far our food travels before it arrives on our plate. We will be using maps to locate the different continents and different oceans that our food crosses to reach us. We will be completing this topic with a mini project around making our own smoothie. This will include market research, tasting ingredients and making a product to a budget.

Our class assembly this term is on 29th June.

Science: Plants.

We will be looking at the different parts of a flower and what they need in order to survive. We will base these lessons around practical experiments. The children will then continue their investigation as a small project at home with a bean seed. Each pupil will be given a seed and a journal to record what a plant needs and will be responsible for their own plant.

We will investigate how water travels in a plant and a flower's role in the pollination process.
