Date: Summer 2017

English

The Black Dog-

Spell regular plural nouns by adding suffixes -s or -es.

Add suffixes to verbs where no change is needed in the root word spelling (*helping, helped, helper*).

The day the crayon quit-

Join words and clauses using 'and'.

Spell words containing phonemes already taught in phase 5 phonics.

Spell common exception words and days of the week.

Maths

Read, write and interpret maths statements involving addition, subtraction and equals sign.

Double and halve numbers to 30.

Start using objects, pictorial representations and arrays to compete multiplications.

Compare, describe and solve practical problems for:

- Length and height e.g. long/short, longer/shorter
- Mass or weight e.g. heavy/lighter, heavier than and lighter than.
- Capacity and volume e.g. full/empty. More than and less than.

Topic: Explorers

DT

In DT we are making a bag to carry our treasure from around the world. Children will:

- Design purposeful, functional, appealing products for themselves.
- Select from and use a range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks such as cutting and shaping.
- Select from and use a wide range of materials and components, including construction materials, and textiles.

- Identify, name and describe different materials.
- Compare different materials and their properties.
