English

Maths

Firstly, we have focused on place value, as this is fundamental skill in maths. We will then progress onto the 4 operations: multiplication, division, addition and subtraction.

Fractions- we will be building on our existing knowledge of fractions, placing them on number lines and finding amounts using fractions.

Then we will finish the term on measurement topics: money and time.

Topic: Stone Age
