Design Technology

Applying our knowledge of and the ability to draw diagrams of the circuits and explain how they work.

Science

Electricity and circuits
We will be looking at sources of electricity including identifying renewable and non-renewable sources. Children will identify where equipment gets its power, either mains or battery and how we can use electricity safely.
We will then be planning and making our own working circuits with various components and representing them using symbols in circuit diagrams. We will learn how conductors and insulators can make switches and dimmer switches.
We will be planning and conducting our own experiments: designing fair tests, making predictions, observing and measuring, using tables/ graphs to present results, reaching conclusions.
