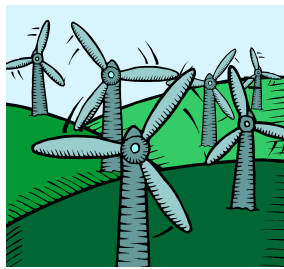

**“Create, Connect and Share Respect: A better internet starts with you”.**

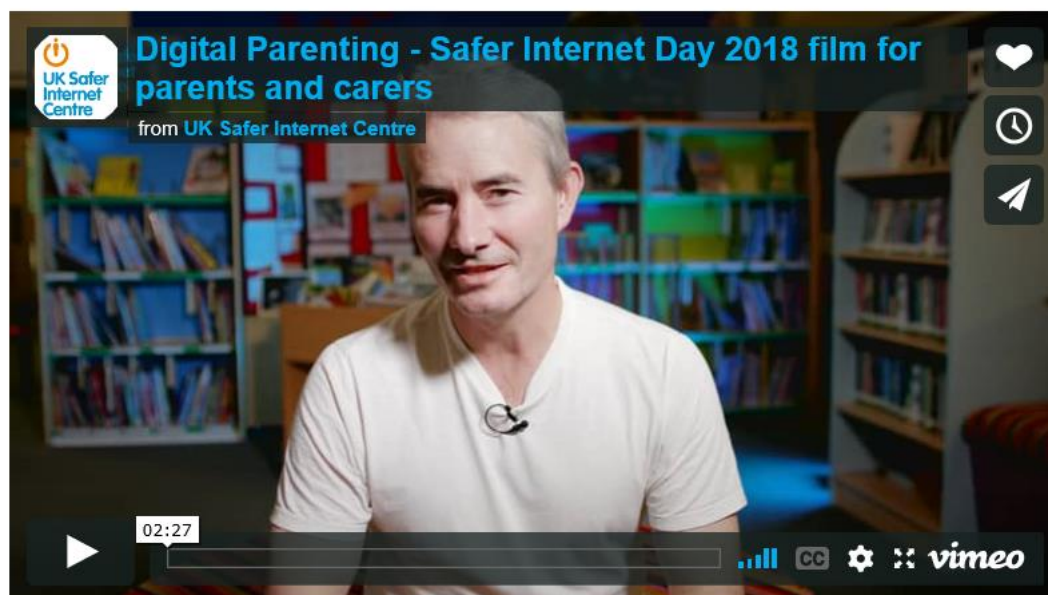
In school, assemblies and computing lessons are focused around e-safety this week. Useful resources for parents to help explore topics relating to online safety can be found by following the link below:
