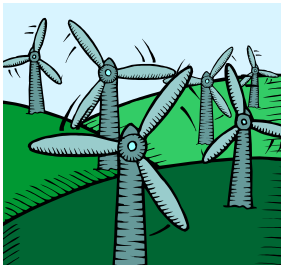

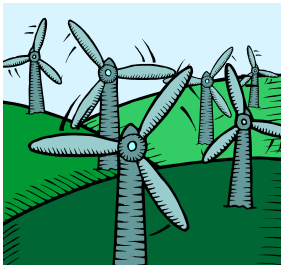
## P.E.
